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NRA Basic Pistol Course Outline

Course Goal: To teach the basic knowledge, skills and attitude necessary for owning and using pistol safely.

Length of Course: 10 hours minimum (Additional time may be given in order for students to develop skills before moving on to the next lesson.)

Student Text: The Basics of Pistol Shooting Handbook. (Provided)

Course Lessons:

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| Lesson I: | Pistol Knowledge and safe gun handling (including a practical exercise) revolver and semi-auto | 2 hours |
| Lesson II: | Ammunition knowledge and the fundamentals of pistol shooting | 2 hours |
| Lesson III: | Firing the first shots (shoot from the bench rest position) practice position, dry fire, and live fire, approximately 20 rounds. | 2 hours |
| Lesson IV: | Two-handed and one-handed standing shooting positions (fire from both positions) practice, dry fire, and live fire approximately 30 rounds. | 2 hours |
| Lesson V: | Pistol sports and activities, then review and final exam, student must score a 70% to receive certificate. | 2 hours |
